CREATE at UC San Diego is partnered with Code.org to expand access to computer science in the San Diego region. Starting this summer, Code.org is offering two yearlong professional learning programs that will provide the training teachers need to introduce a CS course to middle and high school students.

Cost: The Early Bird cost for each program is \$800 per teacher (\$900 after April 30, 2019, \$1000 after May 31, 2019), which is more than 60% off the national cost, thanks to the generous support of Code.org and UC San Diego.

Each yearlong program includes a five-day summer workshop, four follow-up days throughout the academic year, teaching materials, workshop supplies, and meals. The curriculum, online student learning platform, and year-round support are available to all schools at no charge.
